ORDINANCE NUMBER 2024- DL

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NUMBER 2022-15A AND THUS ADJUSTING THE RATE FOR COMMERCIAL SANITATION USAGE AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the mayor and counsel of the Village of Bellaire, Ohio recognize the need to adjust the sanitation rate for commercial customers.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BELLAIRE, COUNTY OF BELMONT, STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1: Effective as of April 1, 2024, Section 1 (c) will be replaced as follows:

The monthly commercial rates for non-dumpster weekly pickups shall be as follows: Small quantity, 1 to 5 trash bags: \$18.65

An additional fifty cents (\$0.50) will be assessed to each bag of garbage picked up in addition to the five (5) bag limit.

- **SECTION 2**: That the other provisions of Ordinance Number 2022-15A not specifically changed by this ordinance remain in full force and effect.
- **SECTION 3**: That all other Ordinances or Resolutions, or portions thereof, which are in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed.
- **SECTION 4**: That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
- **SECTION 5**: That this Resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
