

ORDINANCE NUMBER 2026- 19

AN ORDINANCE ADJUSTING THE HOURLY RATE OF PAY FOR CERTAIN EMPLOYEES OF THE VILLAGE OF BELLAIRE AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council of the Village of Bellaire, Ohio recognize the need to maintain good and dedicated employees.

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council of the Village of Bellaire, Ohio likewise recognize the need to periodically review and adjust hourly wages based on job performance and current market pay scales.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BELLAIRE, COUNTY OF BELMONT, STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1: Effective as of June 28, 2026, the hourly base rate shall be adjusted and paid to the following employees of the Village of Bellaire:

SECTION 2: That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3: That this Resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
