

ORDINANCE NO. 26-22

AN ORDINANCE CONFIRMING OWNERSHIP OF STREETS AND VILLAGES WITHIN THE VILLAGE.

WHEREAS, The Village of Bellaire is a Municipal Corporation organized pursuant to the laws of the State of Ohio and is located within Belmont County, State of Ohio.

WHEREAS, the Village has ownership of and maintains the streets, avenues and alleys within its municipal boundaries.

WHEREAS, the Belmont County Engineers office maintains maps of the Village of Bellaire, formerly known as the City of Bellaire, which sets forth all of the Village's claimed ownership of its streets, avenues and alleys.

WHEREAS, the maps of the Village of Bellaire, that is a part of the Belmont County Engineer's records, include a cover sheet that identifies the boundaries of the entire Village and a layout of the 34 numbered streets, avenues and alleys all of which are identified as MUNI map types for the Village of Bellaire.

WHEREAS, Exhibit A is the official map of The Village of Bellaire. The GIS map while unofficial is of assistance in identifying the Village's streets avenues and alleys.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BELLAIRE, COUNTY OF BELMONT, STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1: Attached hereto as Exhibit A is a copy of the Belmont County Engineers cover sheet identifying boundaries of The Village of Bellaire and its 34 numbered Sheets of the MUNI map type. Said maps specifically identify each and every street, avenue and alley within the boundaries of The Village of Bellaire that is owned and maintained by the Village.

SECTION 2: The Belmont County Engineer's office also has available a 2' X 3' map of The Village of Bellaire prepared by GIS Cartography & Publishing Services, a copy of which is attached as Exhibit B, and is available from the Belmont County Engineer's Office. Said map also sets forth all of the streets, avenues and alleys situated within the boundaries of The Village of Bellaire.

SECTION 3: This ordinance confirms that the Village asserts an ownership interest over all of the streets, avenues and alleys within the boundaries of the Village and shown on the maps on record with the Belmont County Engineer's office.


SECTION 4: That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 5: That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.

Adopted at a regular meeting of the Council of the Village of Bellaire held this 2nd day of July, 2026 by the 6 yea votes of its eligible members.
