

RESOLUTION NO. 1133

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE OF BELLAIRE
TO ENDORSE AND ADOPT THE SAFE ROUTES TO SCHOOL
TRAVEL PLAN FOR BELLAIRE LOCAL SCHOOLS AND SEEK
IMPLEMENTATION.

WHEREAS, the Village of Bellaire is committed to improving safe, accessible transportation options for students in accordance with the goals of the Safe Routes to School ("SRTS") Program; and

WHEREAS, SRTS funding is administered by the Ohio Department of Transportation (ODOT) and requires an endorsement by the local jurisdictions of a School Travel Plan to secure funds for project development, planning, and implementation; and

WHEREAS, Bellaire Local Schools, the Village of Bellaire, and Pultney Township have collaborated to create a Safe Routes to School Travel Plan designed to prioritize safety improvements for student pedestrians and cyclists, with the objective of building safer routes to schools and supporting active transportation.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BELLAIRE,
COUNTY OF BELMONT, STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1 : The Safe Routes to School Travel Plan, as presented, is hereby formally endorsed and adopted by the Village of Bellaire. A copy of the Plan is available in the Mayor's office upon request.

SECTION 2: The Mayor, or an authorized designee, is empowered to submit applications for funding, execute agreements, and perform all acts necessary to secure, funding for implementation of the approved priorities within the School Travel Plan.

SECTION 3: That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in

compliance with all legal requirements, including section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 4: That Council hereby declares this Resolution to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, and safety of the citizens

of the Village, and for the further reason that it is of great importance to celebrate and coordinate the commemoration of the 250th anniversary of the United States of America.

SECTION 4: That this Resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
