

ORDINANCE NO. 26-27

**ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING FUNDS TO PAY THE  
TRAVELING CLERK, AUTHORIZING PAYMENT OF THE FINAL  
INVOICE AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.**

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BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BELLAIRE,  
COUNTY OF BELMONT, STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1: The Village entered into an agreement to hire a Traveling Clerk to provide transition services to convert the Village's accounting system to the State Auditor UAN system. After entering into the contract, the scope and duties of the Traveling Clerk expanded as she was acting as the Village's Fiscal Officer due to the resignation of the previous Fiscal Officer.

SECTION 2: The Village appropriates \$25,360.00 from the General Fund to be used for the payment of the Traveling Clerk.

SECTION 3: The Village authorizes payment of the final invoice of \$6,109.20.

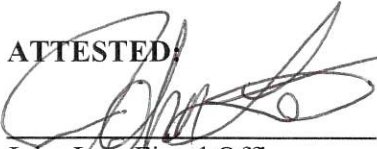
SECTION 4: That all other Ordinances or Resolutions, or portions thereof, which are in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed.

SECTION 5: That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 6: That Council hereby declares this Ordinance to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, and safety of the citizens of the village, and for the further reason that it is of great importance to immediately provide for the proper and usual daily operation of the government of the village.

SECTION 7: That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
