

ORDINANCE NUMBER 2026- 29

**AN ORDINANCE CREATING THE AMLER GRANT FUND, TRANSFERRING FUNDS
AND UPDATING APPROPRIATIONS**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BELLAIRE, COUNTY
OF BELMONT, STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1: The AMLER GRANT FUND, Appropriation Acct 2054-800-500, is established for the purpose of holding funds generated from the AMLER grant and expending those funds for the purposes specified in the AMLER grant.

SECTION 2: That \$599,235.00 in Receipt Acct 2054-411-000 is transferred to Appropriation Acct 2054-800-500.

SECTION 3: That \$599,235.00 is appropriated for immediate use on the recreation project invoices related to the AMLER grant.

SECTION 3: That this ordinance is effective as of August 20, 2026.

SECTION 3: That all other Ordinances or Resolutions, or portions thereof, which are in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed.

SECTION 4: That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 5: That this Resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.

Adopted at a regular meeting of the Council of the Village of Bellaire held this 3rd day of September, 2026 by the 6 yea votes of its eligible members.

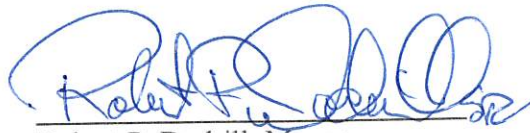
